Specific objectives

- To define a shared and comparable methodology and set of indicators for the NGOs Network reporting activity on measures in response to trafficking, exploitation and slavery in Europe
- To use the identified reporting protocol to analyse, compare and report on the quality and effectiveness of policies, strategies and interventions in response to trafficking in human beings at Member States and at European levels
- To develop a web-based information center for the functional exchange and dissemination of quantitative and qualitative data organized along the identified reporting protocol and indicators

Activities of the project:

1. Analytical and methodological aspects of the reporting activities, in particular the identification of a shared and comparable set of indicators on measures against trafficking.

- Organization of 4 Steering Group's meetings
- Elaboration of a comparable protocol for reporting on measures against trafficking endorsed by the NGOs network in 27 countries

2. Implementation of the national and transnational reporting mechanism.

- Reporting process in the 4 Partners' countries
- Identification of organization/experts in the other EU countries
- Organization of a training session for NGOs from other EU countries
- Reporting process in other EU countries
- Collection of the national reports and elaboration of the transnational section
- Production of the final report
